It was with a great deal of sadness that we learned the passing away of one of our Members, **Mr. Clive William Bauer Oxley, OBE, ED** (岳士禮) on 20th April 2019. His funeral service was held on 8th May 2019 at Christ Church, East Sheen, London, UK.
