OBITUARY NOTICE

We are very saddened to learn of one of our permanent members, **Dr Nip Kam-fan** (聶錦勳) passed away

on 13 March 2021. I have sent condolences to his family on behalf of the Association.

After graduating from HKU with first-class honours in civil engineering in 1956, Dr Nip Kam-fan

worked in the PWD of the Hong Kong government until retiring as Director of Territory Development in

1994. He obtained a PhD and was a pioneer in traffic engineering. He was instrumental in developing

systematic traffic and transport planning in Hong Kong, which began in the 1960s.

As head of the Urban Areas Development Office in the mid-1980s, Dr Nip adapted the new town project

management system for managing development projects in the main urban areas, culminating in the

transformation of NTDD to TDD. He was Director of the Civil Engineering Department before taking up

the directorship of TDD. In these two positions, he had made tremendous contributions to the

urbanisation of Hong Kong.

Dr Nip continued to serve society after retirement. He was instrumental in developing the infrastructure

of the Haven of Hope Hospital. His concern for societal affairs was reflected in his life-long pursuit of

knowledge that extended into humanity, science, education, and religion. He was awarded

academic degrees in many fields in addition to engineering. Dr Nip is held in the highest respect in the

civil service engineering and education professions. We mourn his passing away as a great loss to our

society.

Dr Nip's death is a loss to his many friends in the Association. We will remember him for his shrewdness,

his generosity and his cheerfulness.

The memorial service arrangement will be subject to the COVID-19 pandemic and control measures. The

family will inform us when the details are decided.
